The webpage is managed by UNIFE which will ensure that documents and news are uploaded regularly. The webpage will be maintained during the lifetime of the project and will be active with the latest information at least three years after the end of the project.

2. STRUCTURE OF THE PUBLIC WEBSITE

The content of the website has been organised into different sections as shown in the navigation bar of Figure 2.

When accessing to the website the user is presented with the Home Page which is on the right hand side of the navigation bar. The home page represents the entry point for all website visitors, providing an overview about the project, latest news and events and links to other projects linked to Shift2Rail. Detailed information of the project can be found using the secondary navigation as shown in Figure 2.

The web site also contains a private area as shown on the right hand side of the navigation bar (Figure 2), accessible only through a login process and primarily reserved to consortium members. This private area, called Cooperation Tool, takes the user to an intranet platform that operates as a shared library for document templates, reports, deliverables etc. This tool ensures that all documents related to the project are organised and available to all project beneficiaries.
